- Treasurer's Report
 - Current Budget vs Actuals
 - No significant changes in income, we had additional donations to field trips
 - Still have a large payment to the district for PE & music
 - Teachers & staff have utilized reimbursements for classroom/grade level funds
 - \$17,276 surplus used for the year
 - Added drama/chorus has been added to the budget as a pass through account.
 - Budget Proposal 2023-2024
 - Did 10% cut across the board, then fine tuned
 - Pass through items are the same
 - Decreased teacher & staff individual funds by \$50/classroom
 - Changed grade level funds to flat \$500 per grade, can request surplus funds for any extra (going back to pre-pandemic model)

- Lowered Walkathon budget, in addition to purchasing a few items this year that can be used for multiple events instead of renting each time
- Lowered auction budget in hopes of doing an online auction next year
- Misc. community events upping to \$2k to bring in families and hopefully increase volunteerism
- Comment from Ms. Knudsen: is it fair to have the same amount per grade when some grades (e.g., TK, SDC) are very small?
- Removed the school wide spirit shirt budget, which would have paid for shirts for the 2024-25 school year.
- Surplus Spending Requests
 - Custodian \$2500 for floor scrubber machine- Meeting quorum not reached to vote
 - 3rd Grade Grade Level Supplies \$2900 Meeting quorum not reached to vote.
 - Both items will be tabled until the May 11th HSC meeting.
- Committee Reports/New Business
 - Walkathon (Kira)
 - Will send home a digital flyer tomorrow with volunteer info, pledge info, etc.
 - Prize purchases have been made.
 - Top walker overall will get to be Principal for a day
 - Top walker for each grade gets to be Ambassador for a day teacher for an hour, read to another class, other things they may enjoy, etc.
 - Highest lap count class per grade will get an ice cream party
 - Teacher with the top 2 lap counts will get gift cards
 - 4th Grade Fundraising (Angie)
 - 2 upcoming events (SheShe Boutique on 5/4, After school movie on 5/10)
 - Kona Ice discussion big issues yesterday with everyone rushing out, saving spots, parents yelling, etc. Consider booking it for a weekend in the parking lot or having them come to the picnic instead of after school?
