Principal's & Teacher's Reports [15]

1. Principal Report- Very Excited to be back on campus!

1st grade students have been issued chromebooks and are getting familiar. Steam lab utilized by classes. **Recess 101** is running; P.E. program to help support students during recess by setting up games & activities. 4&5 graders can become a **Recess Leader**.**Rhythm and Moves** for 4&5 grade by a credentialed leader that puts together movement activities for students during teacher prep period every week. **Safety Squad** is a program where 5th grade students help chauffeur other students coming in through the drop off line, and can assist unsure students to class. Working on InHouse field trips for this year. Coming soon: **Art Vista**, **Clay**, **Running Club**.

Grapefruit will be the new testing service we are using for the Covid testing. The turn around on results is 15 minutes compared to Color with 2-3 days. Unions schools will be testing students and staff twice weekly. You can pre-register to test at <u>weekly-covid-testing</u>. Covid testing is optional. The child must consent to testing despite being opted in, Children will not be forced to test.

- 11. Promo/Science Camp 2022 (Nina)- Walden West Scheduled tentatively for the week of May 12, 2022. This years 5th graders were unable to fundraise last year due to Covid. As 3rd graders they had \$4,650 in field trip money that wasn't able to be used for field trips because of Covid. There was a gift of \$6,100 form 2020 Science camp that was Covid cancelled There is currently around \$11,000 for Science camp 2022. The class will need to raise the delta.
